The first class is scheduled for Friday December 12th, from 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. at the Grand Valley Educational Career Center. This training is widely recognized in the Energy Industry, and is accepted by a number of the operators working in the Piceance Basin. The cost for this valuable training is \$125.00 per person which includes instruction, testing, a student workbook, light refreshments, entry in the PEC training database, and the PEC photo ID/Certification card. “I.M.P.A.C.T.” Classes Are Interactive, Fun, and Educational

What does “I.M.P.A.C.T.” stand for?? “Integrity Makes People Across Communities Trust”

This interactive class examines the positive and negative impacts that natural gas exploration can have on a community, and focuses on the expectations that community members have of the companies operating in their “backyard”. Discussions reveal the importance of working with honesty and integrity, and participants recognize the tremendous “ripple effects”, both positive and negative, that their decisions and actions can have in a community. They gain an understanding of how to earn trust from those living in the community where they are working.

Through a variety of learning activities, participants enhance their communication skills, including effective listening and conflict resolution. In addition, they learn valuable decision-making skills that will help them “do the right thing for the right reasons”. Isn’t this what we all want from our employees?

Your employees who attend an “I.M.P.A.C.T.” class will take away valuable tools that will help them help your company enhance its reputation in the communities where you work, as well as in the eyes of the companies for whom you provide services. Each participant also commits to making a difference by personally working to improve a specific area of concern for your company or the oil and gas industry.

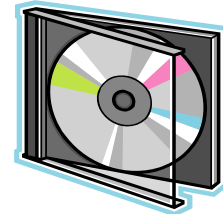

CPR/AED/BLOOD BORNE PATHOGENS RECERTIFICATIONS

The American Red Cross certifications for CPR/AED and Blood Borne Pathogens expire one year from the date issued. Many employees need to attend “Recertification” classes in order to stay “current”. We have morning and afternoon recertification classes scheduled for December 5th and January 16th. These classes last only about three hours, and the cost is just \$50.00 per person. “Free Safety Training Video Library”



A goal of CMC’s Energy Industry Training department is to provide educational opportunities in a variety of formats to allow learning to take place for as many people as possible. The more we receive, the more we will be able to share with all of you.
